### Agenda topic **Music Director Report** |

## DISCUSSION ITEMS |

- Mr. Woodfin indicated that the Boosters have permission to sell pizza to students from Bloomingdale during next home game.
- Winter Guard – two students paid for their own uniforms, when the uniform should have been part of their dues. Mr. Woodfin asked students to provide receipts to review.
- Potluck was suggested for Saturday, October 20<sup>th</sup> to encourage parents to pay for student dues as the next payment is due October 19<sup>th</sup>. Mrs. Holbrook will review with Mr. Woodfin to see if we can proceed.
- Color Guard parent, Doreen, asked if parents can volunteer for an additional three events to waive another students parent fee of \$50.00. It was stated, that Yes. The parent just needs to indicate the name of the student it should be applied too.
- Cheesecake Fundraiser might not be an option again as the company is losing money due to student participation.
- Looking for additional options to fundraise.
- The theatre department will be hosting a suicide walk on December 8<sup>th</sup>. Walk will take place at Al Lopez Park in Tampa. Other groups will be joining the walk. Music Boosters agreed to also participate. More information to follow.
- Jay would like for students to also wear ribbons during Durant High School in support of Kole Smith, football player for Durant that ended up paralyzed from the waist down this past summer.
